Key Stage 1 Standard Assessment Tasks (SATs) Results 2017

These are the Key Stage 1 SATs results for 2017 showing the percentage of pupils achieving at the expected standard (EXS) and working at greater depth than the expected standard (GDS) in Reading, Writing and Maths. Our results are based on 10 eligible children in KS1 (each child representing 10% of the total percentage).

End of Key Stage 1 attainment at the expected standard is in line with national benchmarks in Reading, Writing and Maths in 2017.

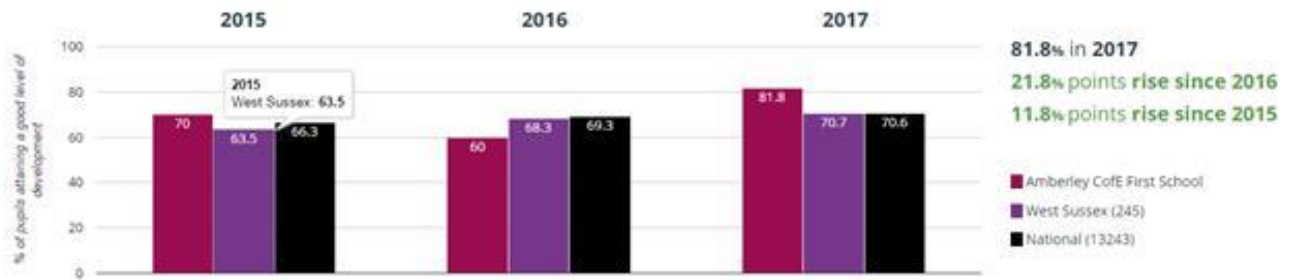

EYFS

Current Attainment –

EYs judgements were moderated in May 2017 by the Local Authority (LA). The moderator was satisfied with the judgements made by the EYs team and felt the process was robust and accurate. Of the current cohort of 11 children, 9 children (82%) achieved a Good Level of Development at the end of the year. This is an increase over the last three years showing an upward trend and is also above national benchmarks (71%).

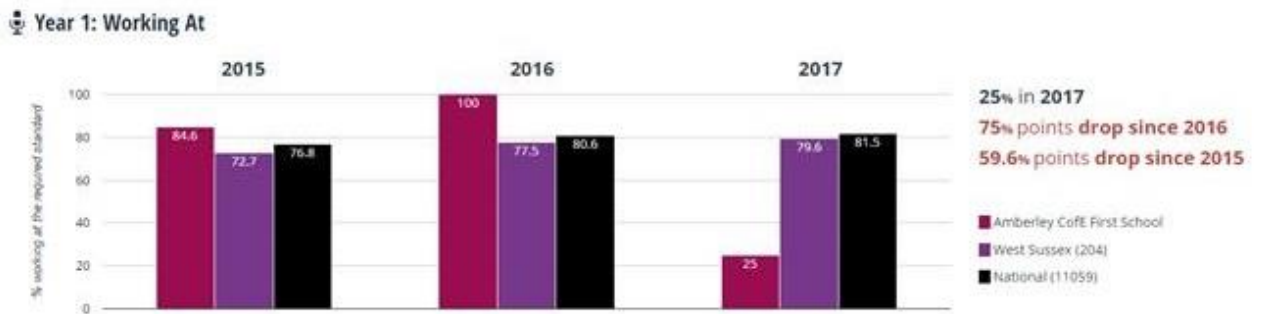


Cohort sizes: 2015 – 10 pupils

Year 1 – Phonics Screening



1/4 (25%) pupils attained the expected mark in the phonics screening test.

No children from Year 2 sat the phonics screening test this year due to the 100% pass rate in 2016.

Key Stage 2

Amberley School has only had a Year 6 since September 2017 so Key Stage 2 results are not available for the school.

Most children transfer to Steyning Grammar School (formerly Rydon Intermediate School) in Storrington at the end of Year 6.
